PENCIL COLOURING

Rules

- > Participants should **report 30 minutes** prior to the competition time.
- > The picture will be given by the organizers before the competition starts.
- > Time allocation for pencil Colouring is maximum 60 minutes
- > All materials required for the pencil colouring must be arranged by the contestants themselves.
- > The Chest number given to the contestant should be written on the top right-hand side of the paper used for drawing.
- > Participants are prohibited from writing their names on the paper, as doing so will result in disqualification.
- > The organizers have the right to publicize the works in online medias.
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final.

Evaluation Points

> Shading, neatness and beauty of the strokes.

PENCIL DRAWING

Rules

- > Participants should **report 30 minutes** prior to the competition time
- > The topic will be given by the organizers before the competition starts
- Time allocation for pencil drawing is maximum 120 minutes
- > All materials required for the pencil drawing must be arranged by the contestants themselves
- > A3 sized, white-coloured handmade paper should be used for the drawing and will be provided by the organizers
- > The chest number given to the contestant should be written on the top right-hand side of the paper used for drawing
- > Participants are prohibited from writing their names on the paper, as doing so will result in disqualification.
- Only graphite pencils should be used for the drawing
- > The drawing should not contain anything detrimental to the law and prestige of this country
- The organizers have the right to publicize the works in online medias.
- Use of drawing templates NOT allowed.
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final.

- Proportion, shading, neatness, imagination, and beauty of the strokes.
- > Ability in doing portraits and scenery, light and shade, imagination, perception, completeness
- > Relation to the given topic, Composition.

DRAWING WATERCOLOUR

Rules

- > Participants should **report 30 minutes** prior to the competition time
- > The topic will be given by the organizers before the competition starts
- Time allocation for painting is maximum 120 minutes.
- All materials required for the painting must be arranged by the contestants themselves.
- > A3 sized, white-coloured handmade paper should be used for the painting and will be provided by the organizers
- The chest number given to the contestant should be written on the top right-hand side of the paper used for painting.
- > Participants are prohibited from writing their names on the paper, as doing so will result in disqualification
- Only watercolours should be used for the painting.
- > The painting should not contain anything detrimental to the law and prestige of this country.
- ➤ The organizers have the right to publicize the works in online medias.
- Use of drawing templates NOT allowed.
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final.

- Proportion, shading, neatness, imagination, and beauty of the strokes.
- > Ability in doing portraits and scenery, light and shade, imagination, perception, completeness.
- > Relation to the given topic, Composition & style

CARTOONS

Rules

- > Participants should **report 30 minutes** prior to the competition time
- > The topic will be given by the organizers before the competition starts
- Time allocation for drawing is maximum 120 minutes.
- > All materials required for the drawing must be arranged by the contestants themselves.
- > A4 size white paper should be used for the drawing and will be provided by the organizers.
- > The Chest number given to the contestant should be written on the top right-hand side of the paper used for drawing.
- > Participants are prohibited from writing their names on the paper, as doing so will result in disqualification
- Only black colour should be used for drawing.
- > The drawing should not contain anything detrimental to the law and prestige of this country.
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final.
- > The organizers have the right to publicize selected works online

- > Innovative interpretation of the theme
- Cartoon clearly reflects the given topic/theme
- Neatness and finishing
- ➤ Ability to communicate humor, emotions, or satire effectively

OIL PAINTING

Rules

- > Participants should **report 30 minutes** prior to the competition time
- ➤ The topic will be given by the organizers before the competition starts.
- Time allocation for painting is maximum 120 minutes.
- > All materials required for painting must be arranged by the contestants themselves.
- ➤ A3 size (12 "x16") canvas should be used for painting and will be provided by the organizers.
- > The chest number given to the contestant should be written on the top right-hand side of the paper used for painting.
- Only oil paints should be used for painting.
- > The painting should not contain anything detrimental to the law and prestige of this country.
- The organizers have the right to publicize selected works online.
- > Use of drawing templates NOT allowed
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final.

- Proportion, shading, neatness, imagination, and beauty of the strokes.
- > Ability in doing portraits and scenery, light and shade, imagination, perception, completeness.
- > Relation to the given topic, Composition & style

POEM WRITING

Rules

- > Participants should **report 30 minutes** prior to the competition time
- > The topic will be given by the organizers before the competition starts
- > The Chest number given to the contestant should be written on the top right-hand side of the paper
- > Participants are prohibited from writing their names on the paper, as doing so will result in disqualification
- ➤ The duration of the competition will be maximum 90 minutes
- The writing should be in specified language only.
- > Referring and copying from the other works or books during the competition will not be permitted.
- > The writing should not contain anything detrimental to the law and prestige of this country.
- Decisions made by the judges will be final.
- The organizers have the right to publicize selected works online.
- Writings that do not comply with the above rules will be disqualified
- > Electronics gadgets will not be permitted

- > Presentation of the theme, the flow of language, choice of words, and style of narration, artistic creativity
- Shows imaginative use of language.
- Depth of emotion and overall impression.
- Unique ideas, fresh perspective.

STORY WRITING

Rules

- > Participants should **report 30 minutes** prior to the competition time
- > The topic will be given by the organizers before the competition starts
- > The Chest number given to the contestant should be written on the top right-hand side of the paper.
- > Participants are prohibited from writing their names on the paper, as doing so will result in disqualification
- > The duration of the competition will be maximum 90 minutes
- The writing should be in specified language only.
- > Referring and copying from the other works or books during the competition will not be permitted.
- > The writing should not contain anything detrimental to the law and prestige of this country.
- Decisions made by the judges will be final.
- > The organizers have the right to publicize selected works online.
- Writings that do not comply with the above rules will be disqualified
- > Electronics gadgets will not be permitted

ESSAY WRITING

Rules

- > Participants should **report 30 minutes** prior to the competition time
- > The topic will be given by the organizers before the competition starts
- > The Chest number given to the contestant should be written on the top right-hand side of the paper
- > Participants are prohibited from writing their names on the paper, as doing so will result in disqualification
- > The duration of the competition will be maximum 90 minutes
- The writing should be in specified language only.
- > Referring and copying from the other works or books during the competition will not be permitted.
- > The writing should not contain anything detrimental to the law and prestige of this country.
- Decisions made by the judges will be final.
- > The organizers have the right to publicize selected works online.
- Writings that do not comply with the above rules will be disqualified
- Electronics gadgets will not be permitted

- > Presentation of the theme, the flow of language, choice of words, and style of narration, artistic creativity
- Shows imaginative use of language.
- > Depth of emotion and overall impression.
- ➤ Unique ideas, fresh perspective.

ACTION SONG

Rules

- No property shall be used
- Use of karaoke is not allowed
- > External interference is not allowed
- You can choose any costume that is suitable for the song
- Action song should be in specified language only (English/Malayalam)
- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- Time allocation is maximum 5 minutes.
- Decisions made by the judges will be final.

- Perfect timing of actions
- > Facial expressions, enthusiasm, and liveliness.
- > Innovative actions and choreography.
- > Clear lyrics and articulation
- Costumes, stage presence, and visual appeal

STORY TELLING

Rules

- No property shall be used
- > External interference is not allowed
- > The story should be in specified language only
- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- > Time allocation is maximum 5 minutes.
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final.

Evaluation Points

> Suitable facial expressions, Absorbing the essence and message, clarity and correct pronunciation, appropriate introduction, and voice modulation, memorization

ELOCUTION

Rules

- > The topic for the elocution will be given by the organizers 30 minutes before the competition starts
- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- > The speech should be completely memorized and should not be read. Contestants can use the points from any books or quotes.
- > Performances that offend any individual or religious-political organizations will not be allowed.
- > A prompt will be given 4 minutes after the start of the performance and a warning signal will be given at 5 minutes to wind up the speech.
- > Only the specified language shall be used.
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final.

Evaluation Points

> Time Limit, in-depth knowledge of the topic, logical arrangement of points, the flow of language, grammatical correctness, appropriate poise gestures, facial expressions, voice modulation, and confidence.

LIGHT MUSIC

Rules

- > The light music should be expressional.
- No property shall be used
- Accompanist not allowed
- > Film songs, devotional songs, album songs, bhajans and ghazals should not be included in the singing.
- Only Malayalam songs are allowed
- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- Time allocation for light music is maximum 5 minutes.
- > Ensure vocal quality, expression & pronunciation.
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final.

Evaluation Points

- ➤ Performance, vocal Technique Tone Quality, Breath Support, Intonation, Diction, Articulation rhythm, and tempo.
- > (Sangeetha Njanam-Shareeram -Sruthilayam- Njana bhavam Shabda Shruti-Thalam).

- > Points will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
- > Failure to adhere to the language and content guidelines (i.e., performing non-Malayalam songs) will also result in disqualification.

MAPPILAPPATTU

Rules

- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- > Only Malayalam songs will be allowed.
- > Time allocation for Mappilappattu is maximum 5 minutes.
- > Mappilappattu songs with unique ishals should be performed.
- > It is not compulsory to perform only traditional songs.
- > Film songs must not be performed.
- No Karaoke will be allowed
- Decisions made by the judges will be final.

Evaluation Points

➤ Performance, vocal Technique – Tone Quality, Breath Support, Intonation, Diction, Articulation rhythm, and tempo.

Penalties

POEM RECITATION

Rules

- > No property shall be used
- > External interference is not allowed
- > The poem should be in specified language only
- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- > Time allocation is maximum 5 minutes.
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final.

Evaluation Points

> Suitable facial expressions, conveying the meaning and message, clarity and correct pronunciation, and voice modulation, memorization

Penalties

CLASSICAL MUSIC

Rules

- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- ➤ It is permissible to use a "Sruthi box" for the competition. The devices shall be arranged by participants.
- > Using a recorded Sruthi is also allowed.
- > The competitor can sing in the raga of their choice.
- Only Carnatic music is allowed
- Time allocation for Classical music is maximum 10 minutes.
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final.

Evaluation Points

- > Ensure vocal quality, expression & pronunciation.
- > Performance, vocal Technique Tone Quality, Breath Support, Intonation, Diction, Articulation rhythm, and tempo.
- > (Shareeram -Sruthilayam- Njana bhavam-Bhava Shudhi-Thalam- Manodharmam.)

Penalties

MONO ACT

Rules

- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- > Time allocation for Mono Act is maximum 5 minutes
- ➤ Language Malayalam or English
- > Properties should not be used
- > Offensive references should be avoided.
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final.

Evaluation Points

> Clarity of pronunciation, Clarity of ideas, Emotional expression (Bhava Abhinayam), Dialogue, Theme and characterization

Penalties

FANCY DRESS

Rules

- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- > Participants can choose the theme and character.
- No dangerous materials are allowed
- > Recorded description of the performance are allowed.
- > Be careful not to use religious/political/controversial themes.
- > Themes, songs, costumes and makeup should be appropriate for school level competitions.
- Respect the culture and heritage of this Nation
- ➤ Each participant is allowed a maximum of 2 minutes for their presentation and maximum of 3 minutes for preparation on the stage. A grace period of up to 10 seconds may be allowed, but exceeding this will result in point deductions.
- > Decisions made by the judges will be final

Evaluation Points

Creativity, presentation, and costume.

- Points will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
- > Points may also be deducted for inappropriate content or failure to adhere to the spirit of the competition.

FOLK DANCE

Rules

- > Solo performance event
- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- > Folk dance should be performed with the necessary costumes and makeup. Folk solitude should be preserved.
- Song USB should be handed over to program committee while collecting the chest number.
- > Song used for the dance should be clear and audible.
- No extra stage setting will be permitted.
- > Participants can use properties
- Time allocation for Folk Dance is maximum 5 minutes.
- Decisions made by the judges will be final
- Make-up and costumes to be arranged by participants

Evaluation Points

- > Overall performance, Facial expressions and Mudras, movement and rhythm, costume and visual appeal.
- > Vesham, Akara sushama, Bhava Prakadanam, Mudra, Thalam, Adavu.

- > Points will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
- > Failure to comply with costume, music, and performance guidelines may result in deductions or disqualification

KUCHIPPUDI

Rules

- > This event is only for girls
- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- > The performance should be in proper make-up and costume.
- > Appropriate costume should be worn for Dance performance which reflect Dance category
- Song USB should be handed over to program committee while collecting the chest number.
- Song used for the dance should be clear and audible.
- No extra stage setting will be permitted.
- > Participants can use properties
- Time allocation is maximum 10 minutes.
- Decisions made by the judges will be final.
- Make-up and costumes to be arranged by participants

Evaluation Points

- > Overall performance, Facial expressions and Mudras, movement and rhythm, costume and visual appeal.
- > Vesham, Akara sushama, Bhava Prakadanam, Mudra, Thalam, Adavu.

- Points will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
- > Failure to comply with costume, music, and performance guidelines may result in deductions or disqualification

MOHINIYATTOM

Rules

- > This event is only for girls
- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- > The performance should be in proper make-up and costume.
- > Appropriate costume should be worn for Dance performance which reflect Dance category
- > Song used for the dance should be clear and audible.
- > Time allocation is maximum 10 minutes.
- Decisions made by the judges will be final
- Make-up and costumes to be arranged by participants

Evaluation Points

- > Overall performance, Facial expressions and Mudras, movement and rhythm, costume and visual appeal.
- > Vesham, Akara sushama, Bhava Prakadanam, Mudra, Thalam, Adavu.

- > Points will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
- Failure to comply with costume, music, and performance guidelines may result in deductions or disqualification

BHARATHANATYAM

Rules

- > This event is only for girls
- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- > The performance should be in proper make-up and costume.
- > Appropriate costume should be worn for Dance performance which reflect Dance category
- Song USB should be handed over to program committee while collecting the chest number.
- Song used for the dance should be clear and audible.
- No extra stage setting will be permitted.
- > Participants can use properties
- > Time allocation is maximum 10 minutes.
- Decisions made by the judges will be final
- > Make-up and costumes to be arranged by participants

Evaluation Points

- > Overall performance, Facial expressions and Mudras, movement and rhythm, costume and visual appeal.
- Vesham, Akara sushama, Bhava Prakadanam, Mudra, Thalam, Adavu.

- Points will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
- > Failure to comply with costume, music, and performance guidelines may result in deductions or disqualification

CINEMATIC DANCE

Rules

- > The Chest number provided by the organizers must be worn by the contestant during the competition.
- > Cinematic dance should be performed with the necessary costumes and makeup.
- Song USB should be handed over to program committee while collecting the chest number.
- > Song used for the dance should be clear and audible.
- > The dance music can be one song or a mix of songs.
- Indian / Western / Remix / Album songs will be allowed.
- No extra stage setting will be permitted.
- > Participants can use properties
- Time allocation for Cinematic Dance is maximum 5 minutes.
- > Props may be used to enhance the performance, provided they are safe, non-disruptive, and appropriate for the dance
- > Full adherence to safety regulations and cultural appropriateness is mandatory.
- Decisions made by the judges will be final
- Make-up and costumes to be arranged by participants

Evaluation Points

> Overall performance, dress, music, movements, rhythm, steps and presentation.

- > Points will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
- Failure to comply with the music, costume, and performance guidelines may result in deductions or disqualification.
- ➤ Use of inappropriate or unsafe props will lead to deductions or disqualification.

GROUP COMPETITION ITEMS

GROUP DANCE

Eligibility:

- Each team must consist of 7 members, and all participants must be aged between 7-12 (junior) & 13 to 18 (Senior)
- > This event is only for girls

Duration:

> Each team is allowed a maximum performance time of 10 minutes.

Content:

- > The performance should blend classical dance elements with modern or folk influences, primarily set to Malayalam music (80% Malayalam and 20 % any other language).
- > Participants must use recorded songs, and these should be submitted on a USB to the program committee when collecting the chest number.
- > Props may be used to enhance the performance, provided they are safe, non-disruptive, and appropriate for the semi-classical dance form.

Evaluation Criteria:

- > Overall Performance: Energy, interpretation, and overall impact of the dance.
- Facial Expressions and Mudras: Conveyance of emotion and narrative through facial expressions and hand gestures.
- > Movement and Rhythm: Fluidity, grace, and technical execution of movements, including adherence to rhythm.
- > Costume and Visual Appeal: Authenticity, aesthetic quality, and appropriateness of the costume and overall appearance.
- Formation, Creativity, and Synchronization: Originality in choreography, effectiveness of formations, and synchronization in group performances.

CINEMATIC DANCE - FEMALE/ MALE/ MIXED

Eligibility:

Each group must consist of 4 to 10 members, and all participants must be aged between 7-12 (Junior) & 13 to 18 (Senior)

Duration:

> Time allocated for each performance is 5 minutes.

Content:

- > The dance should be based on cinematic (film-related) themes and styles. It may include a mixture of various dance forms but should primarily reflect cinematic influences. Remix can be used. Classical dance performed with film music may lead to disqualification.
- > Recorded music must be used for the performance. Team should submit their song USB to the program committee when collecting their chest number.
- > Props may be used to enhance the performance, but they must be safe, non-disruptive, and appropriate for the dance.

Evaluation Criteria:

- > Overall Performance: The energy, enthusiasm, and overall impact of the dance performance.
- Facial Expressions: Ability to convey emotions and enhance performance through facial expressions.
- Movement and Rhythm: Coordination, fluidity, and rhythm in dance movements that align with the music.
- Costume and Visual Appeal: Appropriateness and creativity of costumes, contributing to the theme and visual impact of the performance.
- Formation and Synchronization: Creativity in formation changes and the ability to remain in sync as a group throughout the performance.
- > Theme and Creativity: Originality and clarity of the chosen theme, and creative interpretation and execution in the dance.

Notes:

- > Full adherence to safety regulations and cultural appropriateness is mandatory.
- Participants must provide their own costumes and props.
- > The decision of the judges is final and binding.

- Points will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
- Failure to comply with costume, music, and performance guidelines may result in deductions or disqualification.
- > Use of inappropriate or unsafe props will lead to immediate disqualification.

OPPANA COMPETITION - FEMALE

Eligibility:

Each team may consist maximum 10 members, and all participants must be aged between 7-12 (Junior) &13 to 18 (Senior)

Duration:

> Each team is allowed a performance time of 10 minutes.

Content:

- > The performance should be based on traditional Oppana styles and formats. Creative interpretations that respect traditional boundaries are encouraged.
- > The presence of a Manavatti (bride character) is mandatory
- > Recorded/ or ive music may be used for the performance. Groups should submit their song USB to the program committee when collecting their chest number.
- > Props may be used to enhance the performance, provided they are appropriate for the dance and do not detract from the traditional aspects of Oppana.

Evaluation Criteria:

- > Overall Performance: The energy, coordination, and overall impact of the group's performance.
- Facial Expressions: Ability to convey emotions and complement the performance through expressive facial gestures.
- > Movement and Rhythm: Precision and grace in dance movements, synchronization with the music, and rhythmical accuracy.
- > Makeup, Costume, and Visual Appeal: Authenticity and attractiveness of the makeup and costumes, contributing to the overall visual appeal of the performance.
- Formation and Synchronization (15 points): Effectiveness of formation changes, and the group's ability to remain in sync throughout the performance.
- > Artistic Interpretation and Cultural Authenticity (15 points): Respect for traditional elements while introducing creative interpretations that enhance performance.

DRAMA

- > The total duration allowed for Drama performance is 30 minutes.
- The maximum time allowed for stage setup is 15 minutes.
- Participants may present a one-act play or selected segments from a larger drama.
- > USB may be used for background music in drama performances.
- > Themes should be socially relevant, culturally sensitive, and non-controversial.
- > Props and sets are typically allowed to enhance performance, but they must be easily portable and set up quickly
- Accompanies should be with in the same age group

Evaluation Criteria

- Acting and character portrayal
- Direction and flow
- > Script quality and relevance
- Stage usage and set design
- > Team coordination and timing

GROUP SONG

Team Composition:

> Each team must consist of 7

Song Selection:

- Only Malayalam songs are allowed
- > Only non-film songs are permitted.
- > Religious or political songs are not allowed.

Time Limit:

- Maximum performance time: 10 minutes (including entry, introduction, and exit).
- > Exceeding the time limit may lead to negative marking or disqualification.

Accompaniment:

Live instruments and pre-recorded vocals are not allowed.

Presentation

- > Teams must maintain proper stage discipline.
- > Costumes should be neat and appropriate to the theme.

Evaluation Criteria:

- Vocal Quality & Clarity
- > Harmony & Synchronization
- > Expression & Stage Presence
- > Song Selection & Musical Arrangement
- Overall Impact

- > Use of film songs is not allowed
- > Exceeding time limit by more than 30 seconds
- ➤ Use of pre-recorded vocals and live instruments

THIRUVATHIRA

Team Composition:

- > A team consists of 8 participants.
- Only girls are allowed to participate in this group dance event.

Time Limit:

- Maximum performance time: 10 minutes (including entry, introduction, and exit).
- Exceeding the time limit may result in penalties or deduction of marks.

Presentation:

- > Thiruvathirakali should feature simple traditional Kerala attire.
- > The authenticity of the art form must be preserved.
- Excessive ornamentation should be avoided.

Evaluation Criteria:

- > Originality: Adherence to the traditional Thiruvathira dance form.
- > Chalanam (Movement): Grace, coordination, and synchronization of movements among participants.
- > Rhythm and Timing: Alignment with the music and maintaining the tempo.
- **Expression and Aesthetics:** Facial expressions, grace, and overall presentation.
- > **Team Coordination:** Unity and harmony among the performers in circular or semi-circular formations.
- Judges may also consider the **cultural authenticity** and adherence to traditional choreography.

Penalties: Any deviation from traditional choreography or inappropriate presentation may lead to disqualification.
